Get Over Yourself 1 Corinthians 1:10-17

I. The Appeal (v. 10)

We can <u>disagree</u> without being <u>disagreeable</u>.

Don't malign **Christ's Church** in any way.

II. The Actors (v. 11-13)

"I am of <u>Paul</u>", or "I am of <u>Apollos</u>", or "I am of <u>Cephas</u>", or "I am of <u>Christ</u>." We are to all <u>speak</u> the same thing.

III. The Aim (v. 13)

Disunity in the church _violates_ a basic principle – We are one in Christ.

I won't talk poorly about the **_church**_ to anyone because **_Jesus**_ loves His Church.

Christ ministers through godly _leaders_ and submissive _congregations_.

IV. The Arrangement (v. 14-17)

You were baptized in the name of The <u>Father</u>, The <u>Son</u>, and The <u>Holy</u> <u>Spirit</u>.

If you are a Christian, then you are a <u>minister</u>.

If you are a minister, then you have a **_ministry**_.

CONCLUSION

We are accountable to God how we handle ourselves.

The aim is to _present_ the Good News of Jesus as a _unified_ church.

The arrangement is not for our **_sake**_ or our **_elevation**_ but for His **_glory**_ and **_honor**_.
