JUDGING SIN IN THE LIFE OF THE BELIEVER

- I. The report (v. 1)
- A. It is essential that God's people live godly lives.
- B. Are you living in a way that brings glory to God or are you living as a carnal Christian who brings shame

on the Lord and His Church?

- II. The problem (v. 2)
- A. This isn't just a sadness, it's a sadness as if someone has died.
- B. Our God is a holy God and He demands that we live in a manner that is different from the world.
- C. it is better that our lives on this earth be shortened than to live in such a way that we dishonor our holy God.
- III. The judgment (vv. 3-5)
- A. The lost have got to be confronted with their sin.
- B. When a fellow believer is grieving the Holy Spirit and dishonoring the Church you confront them.
- C. If they don't repent you disassociate with them.
- IV. The consequences of ignoring the problem (vv. 6-8)
- A. If you allow sin to remain in the church it will grow and affect the whole body of Christ.
- B. You must confess your sin to God every day in order that it not affect your walk with the Lord.

- V. Don't associate with immoral believers (vv. 9-13)
- A. Paul's instructions are to disassociate with fellow believers who are in sin.
- B. We desperately need to reach the lost with the Gospel but we must keep the church pure.
