The Wisdom of God in the Gospel

- 1 Corinthians 2
- I. God's Wisdom Cannot Be Dethroned by Man (vv. 6-9)
- A. Before man was created and thought himself wise, God's wisdom existed.
- B. No one on earth could have seen this coming without God revealing it to him.
- II. A God's Wisdom Cannot Be Discovered by Man (v. 10-12)
- A. The moment you gave your life to Christ you received the Holy Spirit who reveals the deep things of God.
- B. God causes the change, not man's words of his wisdom.
- III. God's Wisdom Cannot Be Delivered by Man (v. 13)
- A. God teaches Paul and inspires him to communicate the very thoughts of God.
- IV. God's Wisdom Cannot Be Discerned by Man (v. 14-16)
- A. Men without God can't accept the things of God. It's not logical to them.
- B. You and I have the capacity to understand the things of God because His Spirit dwells in every born-again child of God.

Conclusion: The wisdom of God is learned by being on your knees, being in His Word with a surrendered heart.
